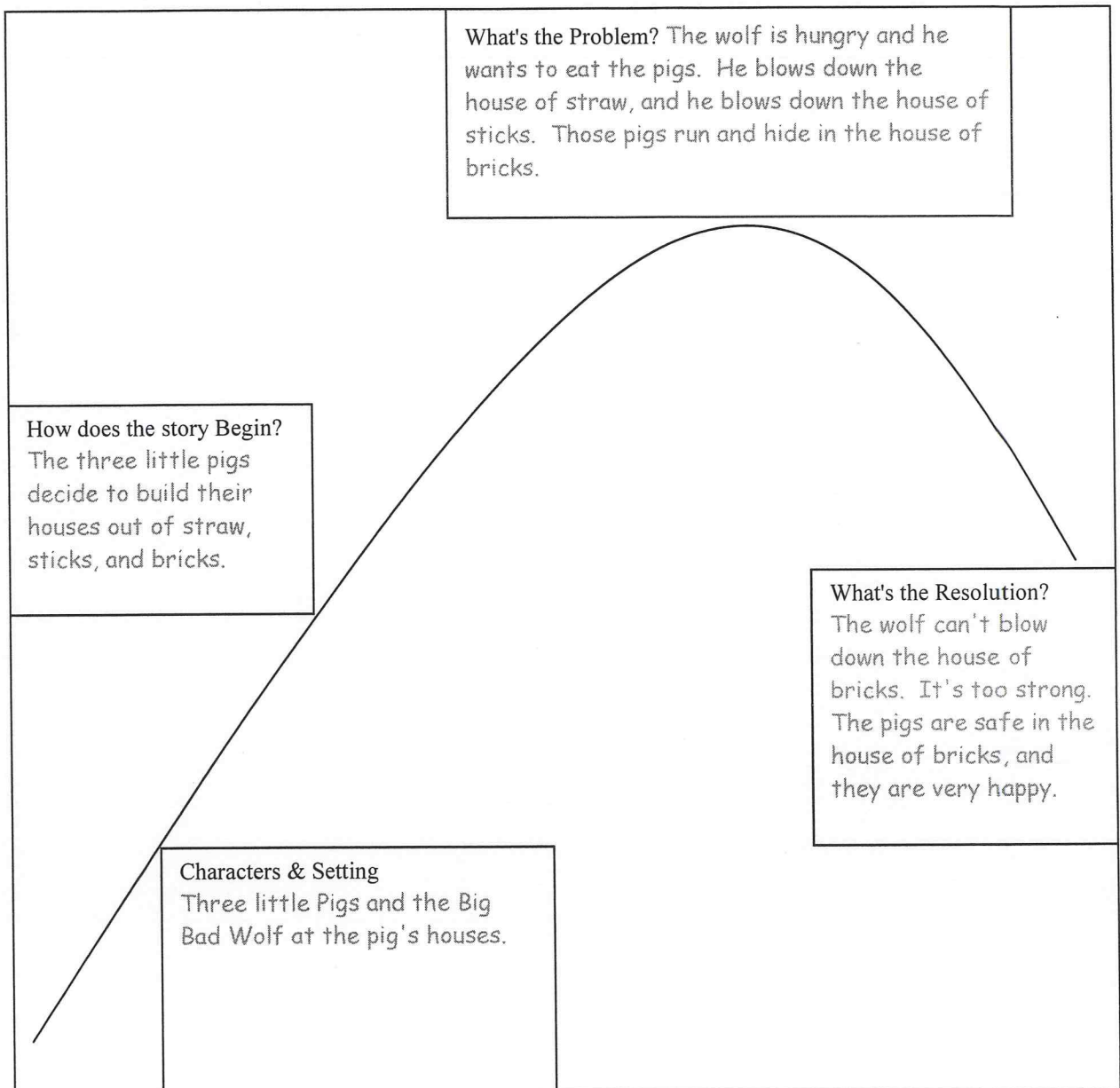


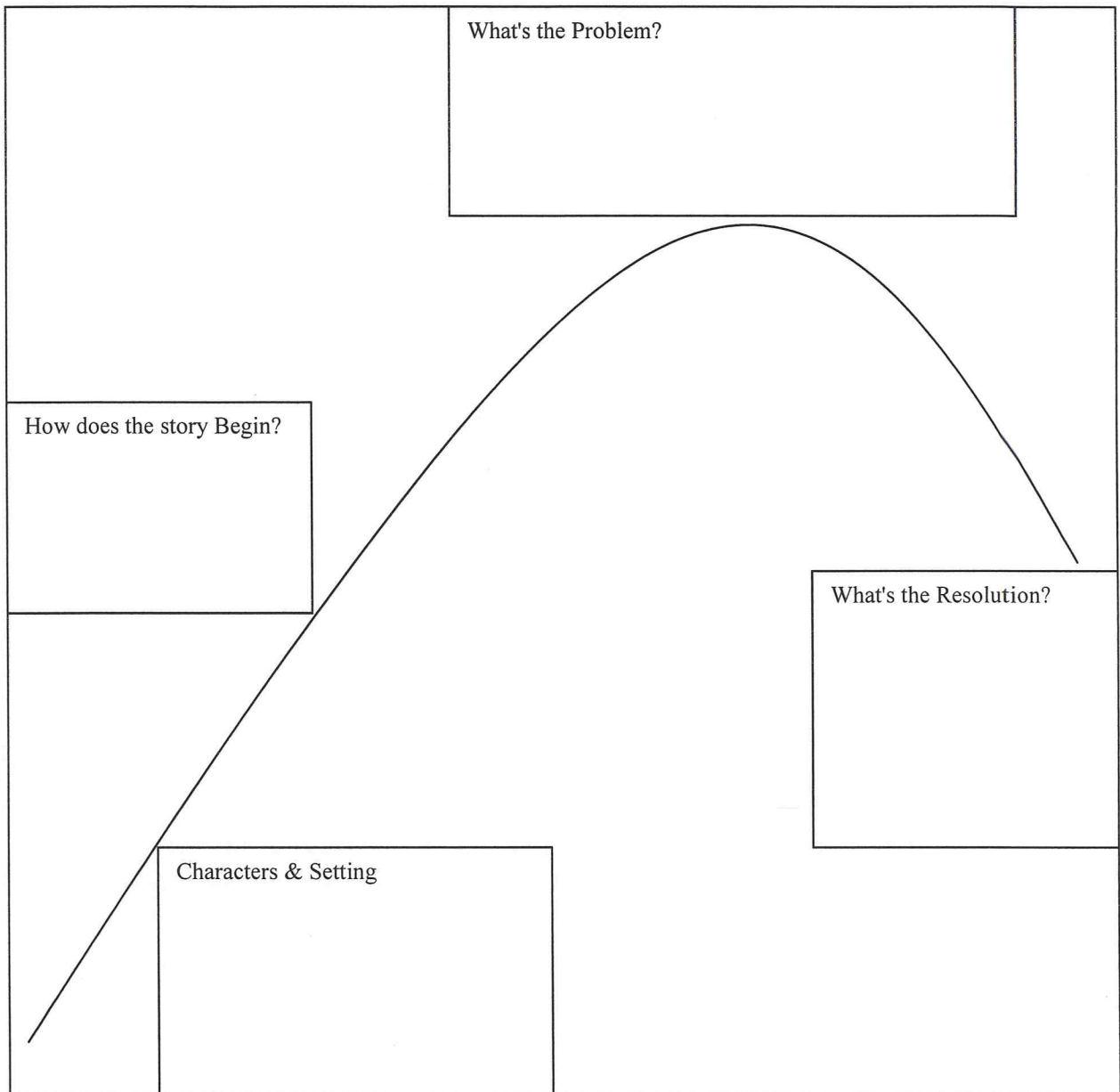
## Sample Plot Diagram:
